EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

While I'm writing this in September 2023, I have been Executive Director of PAL for more than a year already. It is with genuine gratitude to donors like you and with pride that I reflect on 2022, and my first months at PAL.

In fact, 2022 was a year of many positive firsts: We enjoyed partnering with the first female Police Commissioner, Keechant Sewell, to continue a

successful relationship between PAL and the NYPD both for a summer of PLAYSTREETS and for our Police Commissioner For a Day contest; we held PAL's first High School Fair at Harlem Center; we successfully piloted an all-girls basketball clinic in partnership with Grow Your Game to teach skills and drills; with the support of John and Margo Catsimatidis and Fox News, 2022 was the first year every kid attending our Holiday Party received a gift; I could go on with many examples of the good work you made possible. It makes me feel proud and I hope it does the same for you!

Please take the time to read the information in this Annual Report. It outlines the reach PAL has had in 2022, touches on the breadth of our programs, and how we impact the lives of young people from Pre-K through to young adulthood. You will see in the photos some of the ways we keep our youth inspired and motivated: spirited sports matches, cultural celebrations, Arts and STEM activities, and employment/workforce development opportunities. Across all of this, the NYPD continues to be an important partner every day in all of PAL programs and activities. There's much for us to showcase and be grateful for, and we only represent a small slice of it in this limited space.

As I continue through my second year with PAL, I am most excited about what else is possible if we continue to be focused on providing the best opportunities for the youth of NYC. Now that we have had success with one, we will hold more High School Fairs in partnership with other youth-based organizations so we can introduce more young people to higher education opportunities. My hope is to revive PAL's College Access Program, provide college campus tours, and more extensive workforce-readiness programming for young adults post-high school. Our centers need to be open for longer hours so we can provide both safe spaces for families in high-crime areas at the times of day when they most need our support, and we can continue to foster positive relationships between the NYPD and the youth of the communities they serve.

We can only continue our work and our youth can only thrive with your partnership. I hope that you share this vision of a bright future for PAL and the kids we serve, and that you will continue to support us at our events and with your donations.

On behalf of all the dedicated staff here at PAL and the families we serve across all five boroughs, thank you for supporting our mission to help every young person have an equal chance to meet their potential.



While fewer than half (48%) of low-income children are Kindergarten-ready, the vast majority of PAL Head Start kids in 2022 were deemed ready for school.


